

Clinical Research Assessment Volunteer

The Kimel Family Centre for Brain Health and Wellness is the world's first research-based community centre dedicated to reducing dementia risk and examining the benefits of personalized brain health programming for people aged 50+.

As a Clinical Research Assessment Volunteer, you will support the Senior Research Coordinator(s) by assisting with research assessments across physical, sensory, cognitive and functional domains. You will also support data entry on REDCap and contribute to participant feedback sessions. This is an in-person role that supports comprehensive research assessments and accuracy in research data collection.

Responsibilities:

- Assist with general physical examinations including measuring height, weight, blood pressure and heart rate.
- Support administration of sensory tests: vision, hearing and smell tests.
- Help facilitate cognition testing and strength assessments (e.g., grip strength evaluations).
- Observe and assist during radiological procedures such as DEXA scans and muscle ultrasounds.
- Enter participant data into REDCap with attention to accuracy and confidentiality.
- Participate in feedback sessions with participants to discuss their Kimel Family Centre programming strategy, review cognitive test results and other research assessment findings, and share relevant resources for health conditions.

Skills:

- BSc in Health Sciences with 1-2 years of relevant experience.
- Background in medicine or nursing would be an asset.
- Postgraduate certification or diploma (e.g. in clinical research, regulatory affairs or a related field) or Personal Support Worker (PSW) experience would be an asset.
- Demonstrated substantial involvement in hospital or research volunteer roles.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work independently with efficiency and accuracy.

Schedule:

- Typically Monday to Friday, with occasional weekend and evening shifts.
- Shifts may run from 9a.m.-12 p.m. , 12-3 p.m., and/or 3-6 p.m.
- Shifts are in-person only.
